



## Small Sitting Fox

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### Size

12cm (4 3/4") tall, with sport weight cotton and acrylic blend and a 2,50mm hook.

### Difficulty

2. Beginner - suitable for novice crocheters, includes color changes and small details.

### Skills required

Crocheting in spiral, slip stitch, single crochet stitch, increasing and decreasing.

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**Tip!** You can use the same pattern to make larger or smaller toys by using finer or bulkier yarn. Pick a crochet hook at least a size smaller than suggested on the yarn label and crochet tightly enough to achieve a tight gauge that will not allow the stuffing to show through the fabric. You may also need to adjust the size of the safety eyes and nose.

### Materials & Tools

- Yarn. I used sport weight cotton and acrylic blend, 125m = 50g (137yds = 50g) / 5 ply / 12 wpi / 2: light. You will need about 25g of orange, 4g of white and 6g of dark brown yarn.
- 2,25 - 2,75 mm crochet hook (US size 1/B – 2/C) or according to the yarn.
- Polyester fiberfill, wool, wadding etc. for stuffing.
- 9mm (1/3") safety eyes and a 15mm (3/5") triangular safety nose or buttons, beads, felt etc.
- Yarn needle, scissors, stitch marker.



### Abbreviations

- **mr, sc n** = magic ring – crochet *n* single crochet stitches in to the adjustable loop (see page 9).
- **sl st** = slip stitch (single crochet stitch in UK and Australia).
- **sc** = single crochet stitch (double crochet stitch in UK and Australia).
- **sc (or sl st, ch etc.) n** = make *n* single crochet stitches (or sl st, ch etc.), one in each stitch.
- **inc** = increase – crochet two single crochet stitches in the same stitch.
- **inc3** = double increase – crochet three single crochet stitches in the same stitch.
- **dec** = decrease – crochet two stitches together using the invisible decrease method (see page 10).
- **(sc 4, inc) x n** = repeat the pattern between parentheses *n* times.
- **(sc 4, inc) x 6 (36)** = number of stitches in a round after finishing round.

### Notes

- Work in a continuous spiral, do not join rounds or turn, unless instructed otherwise in the pattern.
- Use a stitch marker or a piece of yarn to mark the end or the beginning of a round. Move the marker up after completing each round.
- All stitches are worked in to both loops, unless instructed otherwise in the pattern.

## Color Code

- A** – Main color for the body, in this example orange.
- B** - Color for the muzzle, ears and tip of the tail, in this example white.
- C** - Color for the paws, in this example dark brown.
