Size

30cm (12") tall, with DK weight cotton-bamboo blend and a 2,50mm crochet hook.

Difficulty

3. Intermediate – includes more complicated crochet stitches and techniques, color changes and small details.

Skills required

Crocheting in spiral, crocheting in rounds, chain, slip, single, half double and double crochet stitch, increasing and decreasing.

Tip! You can use the same pattern to make larger or smaller toys by using finer or bulkier yarn. Pick a crochet hook at least a size smaller than suggested on the yarn label and crochet tightly enough to achieve a tight gauge that will not allow the stuffing to show through the fabric. You may also need to adjust the size of the safety eyes.

Materials & Tools

- Yarn. I used DK weight cotton and bamboo blend, 100 m = 50 g (109 yds = 50 g) / 8 ply / 11 wpi. You will need about 40 g of beige, 35 g of white, 8 g of dark beige and 8 g of pink yarn. And about 35 g of DK weight alpaca and silk blend to make the hair.
- 2,25 - 3,25 mm crochet hook (US size 1/B – 3/D) or according to the yarn.
- Polyester fiberfill, wool, wadding etc. for stuffing.
- 12 mm (1/2") safety eyes or buttons, beads, felt etc.
- Cotton embroidery floss in brown and pink.
- Yarn needle, sewing needle, scissors, stitch marker.

Abbreviations

- **st(s)** = stitch(es).
- **mr, sc n** = crochet *n* (*number*) single crochet stitches into the adjustable loop (see page 14).
- **ch** = chain stitch.
- **sl st** = slip stitch (single crochet stitch in UK and Australia).
- **sc** = single crochet stitch (double crochet stitch in UK and Australia).
- **bpsc** = back post single crochet stitch (see page 13).
- **hdc** = half double crochet stitch (half triple or treble crochet stitch in UK and Australia).
- **dc** = double crochet stitch (triple or treble crochet stitch in UK and Australia).
- **fpdc** = front post double crochet stitch (see page 12).
- **dc 2 + ch + dc 2** = crochet all stitches in the same stitch.
- **sc (or ch, hdc etc.) n** = make *n* single crochet stitches (or ch, hdc etc.), one in each stitch.
- **inc** = crochet two single crochet stitches in the same stitch.
- **hdc-inc** = crochet two half double crochet stitches in the same stitch.
- **dc-inc3** = crochet three double crochet stitches in the same stitch.
- **dec** = crochet two stitches together using the invisible decrease method (see page 13).
- **dc2tog** = crochet two double crochet stitches together using the regular method.
- **(sc 4, inc) x n** = repeat the pattern between parentheses *n* times.
- **(sc 4, inc) x 6 (36)** = number of stitches in a round after finishing round.

Notes

- Work in a continuous spiral, do not join rounds or turn, unless instructed otherwise in the pattern.
- Use a stitch marker or a piece of yarn to mark the end or the beginning of a round.
- All stitches are worked into both loops, unless instructed otherwise in the pattern.

Color Code

- A** – Yarn for the body, in this example beige.
- B** – Yarn for the dress, shoes and wings, in this example white.
- C** – Yarn for the soles, in this example dark beige.
- D** – Yarn for details, in this example pink.
- E** – Yarn for the hair, in this example dark brown alpaca and silk blend.
